Health Insurance



- Students from the EU students need to have a valid EHIC (European Health Insurance Card)
- Students from non EU countries need to buy a public or private health insurance for Germany
- Exceptions: Germany has signed agreements with the following countries for the recognition of national health insurance: Bosnia-Herzegovina, Iceland, Israel, Liechtenstein, Morocco, Montenegro, Norway, North Macedonia, Switzerland, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey and UK. Students coming from these countries can apply for a document similar to the EHIC and therefore, usually don't have to purchase additional health insurance (please follow the instructions for EU students)
- You have to get your insurance validated by a German health insurance company. You
 can simply send them an e-mail with your insurance and they will provide you with a
 certificate
- IMPORTANT: Please make sure that the name you tell the health insurance company matches exactly the name on your letter of acceptance!


Enrollment and Cost















